DEMOLITION DERBY MINIMUM UNDERWRITING GUIDELINES (FAIRS)

A. COMPETITION AREA / TRACK REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Positive Barrier Protection: Must be provided for all spectators and non-competing participants. Acceptable materials include concrete walls, D.O.T. (Jersey) Barriers, Armco steel guardrails or horizontal utility poles overlapped and pinned with a minimum diameter of sixteen inches (16"). Minimum acceptable height for the positive barrier shall be thirty two inches (32").
- 2. Crowd Control Fence: Must contain both spectators and non-competing participants behind their respective positive barrier systems by a minimum of fifty (50') feet. Minimum height must be forty-eight inches (42").
- 3. Spectator Seating: Seating area must be located behind the crowd control fence.
- 4. Adequate fire equipment on premises (fire truck and/or currently tagged fire extinguishers around track).
- 5. A paramedic or EMT staffed ambulance will be on the grounds.

B. RESTRICTED AREA PERSONNEL REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Minimum age for drivers is 16. Minimum age for non-competing participants in a restricted area is 14.
- 2. Release and Waiver: K&K approved Waiver & Release must be signed by all persons entering a restricted area. Minor Waiver & Release must be completed by all persons under the age of majority in the residing state.
- 3. Driver Protection: An approved crash helmet, 2000 Snell spec or newer with chin strap is required. Eye protection in the form of goggles or safety glasses is required for any helmet not having a fully functional face shield. A fire retardant driver suit is highly recommended, at a minimum long pants and a long sleeve shirt should be worn. Sturdy boots are recommended over tennis shoes or sneaker type foot wear to provide foot and ankle protection.

C. COMPETING VEHICLE REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Any stock front engine sedan, hard top or station wagon is allowed. No Jeeps, hearses, or limousines are permitted (no engine, transmission, gear or wheel modifications).
- 2. All glass including the windshield, side windows, rear windows, headlights and tail lights must be removed from the vehicle.
- 3. Tires must be street legal (no studs, snow tires or cut treads are permitted). Wheel weights must be removed.
- 4. All doors must be securely fastened with wire or chain; duct tape is not allowed to perform this function.
- 5. All upholstery except driver's seat must be removed. All unnecessary decks, handles, knobs or similar protruding objects must be removed. The interior of the vehicle should be swept clean of any trash or debris; no loose articles are to be present in the interior of the vehicle.
- 6. All competition vehicles must have approved seat belts secured to the frame.
- 7. All competition vehicles must have their hoods securely fastened with no body or fender cut outs. A chain, strong wire or strap must be secured from the center of the roof to the dashboard to act as a center post to minimize the chance of the hood entering the vehicle.
- 8. Stock gas tanks must be removed from their original location. A limited capacity gas tank must be mounted in front of the rear axle, secured by metal straps and covered with a fire proof shield. No reserve tanks are permitted. All caps, fittings and lines must be leak proof.
- 9. The car battery must be securely fastened and covered; if it is moved from its original position, it must be securely attached to the floor board in the passenger compartment and covered to minimize the potential for splashes in the passenger compartment.

D. EVENT RULES:

- 1. The following are grounds for disqualification:
 - Breaching the perimeter of the positive barrier surrounding the competition area.
 - Ignoring the flagman's or any official's direction.
 - Non-compliance with event regulations.
 - Use of alcohol and/or illicit drugs in restricted areas by drivers or non-competing participants.
 - Deliberately targeting a competitor's driver's door.
 - Vehicle on fire.
 - Fighting or the verbal abuse of any competition official.
